

KCB bank donates health equipment valued at 15m/-

KENYA Commercial Bank (KCB) has donated medical equipments worth 15m/- to Makongoro Health Centre here to improve provision of services mainly for expectant mothers and children.

The equipment includes ultra-sound and suction machines which were handed over by Joseph Njile KCB Mwanza branch Manager during a short ceremony held at the centre over the weekend.

Speaking during the hand-over Njile said the equipment would improve health services and enable

the centre, which was facing shortage of the equipment, to serve more people at a time.

He said KCB bank would continue to support provision of health services in the country to enable them provide better health services to the people.

Njile said his bank has supported a number of health centers in Mwanza including provision of medical equipment for mother and child care to Nyamagana clinic.
