

Kondoa dispensary project gets aid

THE Dodoma Regional Commissioner, Dr Rehema Nchimbi, has donated 1m/- towards the construction of Mafai Village Dispensary in Kondoa District.

The RC made the donation yesterday in her two-day tour of the district where she will inspect various development projects especially those related to environment conservation.

The Mafai Dispensary is being constructed by the Kondoa District Council in collaboration with wananchi where to the moment people's contributions have reached 12m/- out of which 6m/- is cash money and the rest is contribution made through donation of labour force and building materials.

The Dispensary is projected to cost 70m/- by the time of its completion and so far the district council has put aside 30m/- to that effect.

Reading Haubi Ward development report to the RC, the acting Ward executive, Mr Disa Masumbuko, noted that the Legislator for Kondoa North, Ms Zabein Mhita, has also joined forces by donating 20 bags of cement.

Together with the ongoing efforts the RC ordered the district executive director to put aside budget for medical equipment and staff for the dispensary to ensure that it starts operations as soon as it is completed.
