1. Joint PPPTWG and National PPP Steering Committee meeting : Monday July 11,2011

Background: In 2007 the MOHSW appointed the NPPPSC (see TOR) to co-ordinate stakeholders initiatives towards a complementary sectoral efforts to improve PPP in Tanzania. The committee achieved among others:

- Fostering establishment of PPP desk in the MOHSW
- Supporting PPP advocacy at regional and Council level.
- Designing and operationalisation of Service Agreement as a PPP tool (at least 15 private facilities/councils SA in place).

The Government has developed a PPP policy (2009), Act(2010) and Regulation(2011). A number of Health Sector Reform developments are on the ground. The initial NPPPSC TOR therefore deserved appropriate orientation to these developments. A first meeting was organized and individual members agreed and brought in proposals for improving the 2007 TOR.

2. SERVICE AGREEMENT CONSULTATIVE MEETING BAGAMOYO JULY 12-14,2011

Background : In the year 2007, the MOHSW,PMORALG, APHFTA,CSSC,BAKWATA jointly with DPs developed the SA as a PPP tool . In 2008 the PMORALg released a circular to all the mainland regions and LGAs to start entering into agreement with private service providers for purposes of accelerating the Primary Healthy Services Development Strategy (MMAM).Until now about 15 of such agreements have been implemented and documented. The meeting was therefore organized by PPP TWG for the first time to consult those who have implemented the tool.

Meeting Objectives:

- To gather SA implementation experiences from sampled LGAs and Service providers
- To share the implementation experiences across implementers and with the authors; MOHSW, PMORALG ,APHFTA, CSSC,Bakwata in order to draw policy implications for improving the tool.

5.PRIVATE HEALTH SECTOR ASSESSMENT

7.AFRICAN REGIONAL PPP MEETING (HEALTH)

It was shared that, An African PPP Meeting (health) will be conducted in Dar es Salaam in 2012. National PPPSC/Coordinating Committee will have to host . DANIDA promised to co-finance the event and proposed to Add one day to allow non-rushed experience sharing. Members thanked DANIDA for having joined the GIZ in this matter. Other DPGs/ stakeholders are kindly requested to support . GIZ –to update on preparation progress soon as details are known
