

# Regency hospital organises free medical camps

ON the auspicious occasion to mark the Holy Month of Ramadhan, the Regency Medical Centre, which is celebrating its 16th Anniversary, has organised free medical camps in Dar es Salaam starting yesterday.

According to the statement released by the Chairman of Regency Medical Center, Dr. Rajni Kanabar, free Juvenile (Paediatric) Diabetic Camp will be every Friday from morning to evening for the whole of July starting yesterday.

Dr. Kanabar said the camp will be attended by Consultant Paediatrician and Endocrinologist, Dr. Rahim Damji at Regency Satellite Clinic, Zanaki Street, Kisutu in Dar es Salaam.

He said free general diabetic camp will be on July 13 and 27 this year, and would be attended by Consultant Physician and Diabetologist, Dr Emmanuel Maganga at Regency Satellite Clinic.

He said during the Diabetic camps that consultation to the medical doctor and random blood sugar testing will be free and those who require 3 months estimation of Blood sugar known as HBA1C (Haemoglycosylated Hemoglobin), which is true index to detect Diabetes will be done at 50 per cent discount by Regency Lancet Laboratories.

Dr Kanabar said free services at eye screening camp would be provided to detect corrective Refractive Errors, Diabetic Retinopathy, Glaucoma, Trachoma and Cataracts. At least 100 patients with cataracts will be selected for Blood less, suture less, latest technology surgery known as Phaco surgery at subsidised rates.

“In the 16th Anniversary of Regency Medical Centre, we joyfully announce free medical camp, and any donation from fellow Tanzanians to give new sight to the needy is welcomed,” he added.
