General principles of the DCF

1. The **government of TZA** must be in the **driver's seat**
2. Sharing a **common vision** in addressing the needs of Tanzania
3. **Commitments** must be honoured by both sides
4. Regular **formal** and **informal forums** for the exchange of views between the government and DPs
5. Adequate **capacity** in government departments
6. **High transaction costs** related to DC must be avoided
7. good **policy design, forward planning** and **effective implementation**
8. Periodic **monitoring** and **evaluation** are crucial for determining whether progress is being made

Sectoral Level Dialogue under the DCF

- “Existing structures and modalities for engagement at the sector level will largely be sustained under the DCF **but subject to reviews as may be agreed among the relevant partners.** The dialogue at this level will be led by the respective Government lead Ministry for the sector.”
- “A **comprehensive review** of the sector groups will be carried out to identify and replicate best practices across all sectors”.

Sector Level Dialogue ctd.

- “Stakeholders will be encouraged to select representatives with whom calendar of meetings, agenda and other channels of communication may be agreed.”
- DPs shall “set up an arrangement of representation that ensures division of labour, continuity of institutional memory, and contributes to effective management.”
