

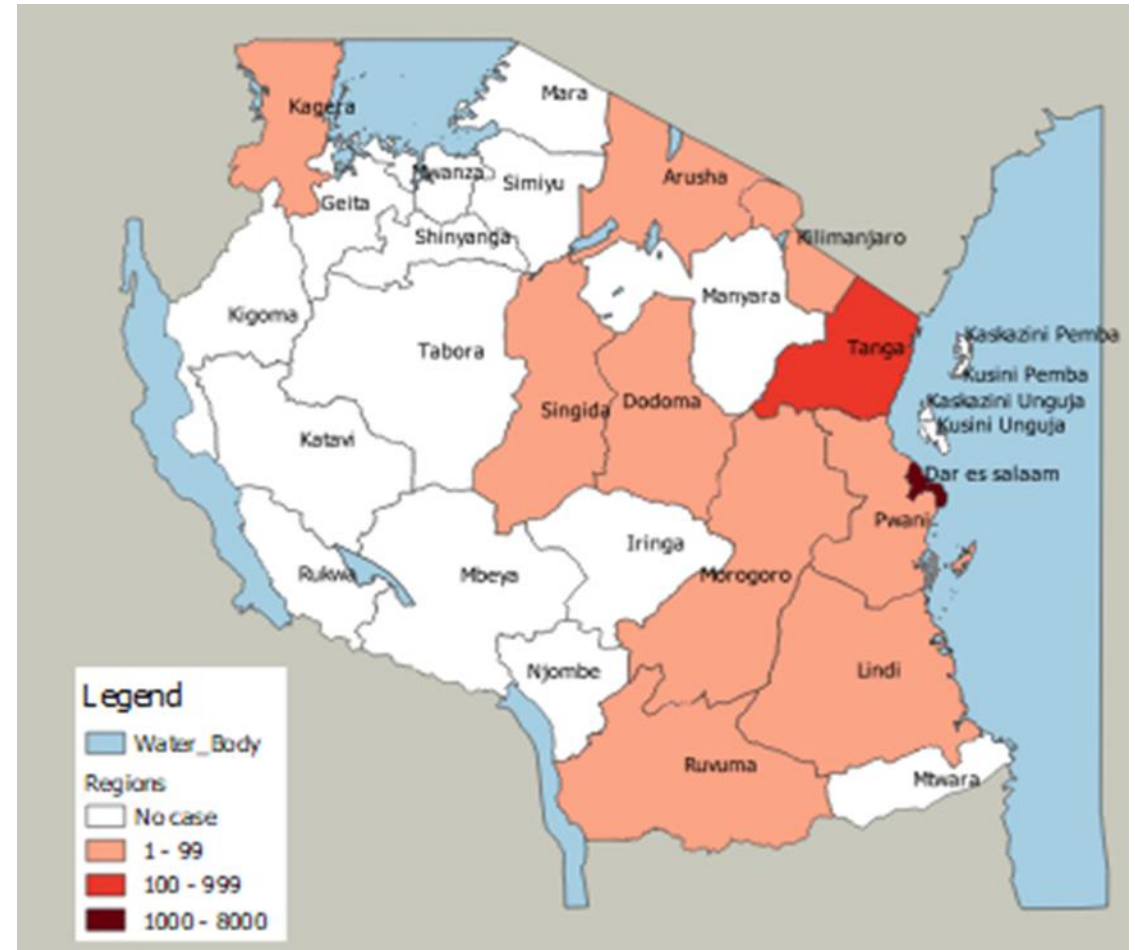

# Updates on Health Emergencies



# Dengue Situation

- **Dengue** as on 30 August 2019; 20 cases (19 Dar es Salaam, 1 Tanga) with zero deaths were reported.
- Dengue Cumulative cases **6906 cases including 13 deaths CFR 0.19%**
- No case of Acute Aflatoxicosis However 53 cumulative cases with 8 deaths had been reported.
- Cholera last reported 14 July 2019.

<b>Coordination</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● NTF meeting held on 23<sup>th</sup> August to enhance below thematic areas.</li> </ul>
<b>Surveillance &amp; Laboratory</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Monitoring of data quality for Dengue surveillance in the reporting regions by daily follow up of Dengue data</li> <li>● National laboratory to continue genotyping and sequencing</li> </ul>
<b>Case Management</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Skills enhancement for management of cases</li> </ul>
<b>Risk Communication</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Community sensitization and mobilization through Radios, TV and key stakeholders ongoing</li> </ul>
<b>WASH and Vector Control</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Four fogging machine distributed in Dar es salaam (3) and Tanga (1) for control of adult mosquitoes</li> <li>● Larviciding is ongoing in Dar es salaam and other malaria/dengue affected regions such as Kigoma, Kagera, Pwani</li> </ul>

# EVD situation in DRC

- ❖ 3036 cases and 2035 deaths CRR 67%
  - Since 15 Aug, 6 cases reported in S-Kivu.
  - Average 60-70 cases per week from 58 HA of 18 HZ
- ❖ 29 Aug 2019, EVD case from Mutwanga DRC crossed to Uganda later died
- ❖ Currently no EVD case outside of DRC

# Summary of EVD Simulation Findings

- High commitment of Regional and District leadership & Health workers
- Health Facilities and Points of Entry (POE) have designated EVD isolation areas that require structure modification
- All Designated Ebola Treatment Centers require structural adjustments
- Basic infrastructure, equipment and supplies, including forms, case definition not available
- Few available HWs trained all need skills enhancement as they showed limited adherence to EVD SOPs
- EVD SOPs are available however they need further review and dissemination



# Summary of EVD Simulation Findings cont...

- Immediate notification done however there is limited attention to **contact identification**
- Limited of clinicians in EVD surveillance
- Coordination between district and regional level however the capacity at district level still low
- Most POEs health centres have **few health workers trained** in EVD response
- Inadequate skills for risk communication among HWs and few IEC materials are available at both regions and district level



# Way forward after EVD Simulation

- Support dissemination of findings in Dodoma with a high-level government of Tanzania officials
- Support dissemination to regions and should be **tagged to planning** for scaling up capacities of EVD preparedness
- Need for partners to commit resources towards EVD preparedness and response
- Review current EVD SOPs in September, translate into Swahili, print and disseminate to lower levels

# Way forward after EVD Simulation cont...

- High need to provide basic equipment/supplies for EVD case management with special focus on IPC, surveillance tools and lab supplies
- WHO to develop a package of simulation modules for periodic EVD training
- Current contingency plan is expiring in Sept 2019 need updating & include refugee populations, EVD vaccine and therapeutics that are being developed
- Vaccine and therapeutics EVD protocols time line has been set for 30 September 2019 and 15 October for vaccine and therapeutics
