### Sector Wide Approach

- Revitalise and rationalise relevant SWAp structures
  - Reformulate TORs for different structures
  - Obtain commitment from all parties to participate in structure
- Increase transparency of TWG activities
  - Documentation and reporting of TWGs
- Cluster TWGs in main outcome areas of HSSP V and building blocks
  - Strategic outcomes of UHC, determinants of health, epidemic preparedness through the lens of People centred care, RMNCAH, HRH, M&E, Health Care Financing
- Decentralize SWAp structures to Regional level

#### **Work Plans for Government structures**

- Produce MOHCDGEC work plan and Common Management Arrangement for implementation of HSSP V
  - Use WHO-AFRO format for operational planning sub-sector
  - Produce rolling three years' work plan (WHO-AFRO format)
- Produce PO-RALG updates for Regional level planning
  - Use WHO-AFRO format for sub-national planning
- Update CCHP guidelines to incorporate HSSP V priorities
  - Update indicators and targets for CCHPs
- Produce MTEF reflecting HSSP V priorities
- Produce Resource Mobilization Plan

# **Harmonise Disease Control Programmes**

- Initiate review committee TWGs with TOR
  - Update all disease control strategies following HSSP V priorities and joint M&E framework
  - Update resources frameworks for disease control strategies
  - Align timeframes for disease control programmes to HSSP V
- Enhance coordination, communication and alignment of disease control programmes in existing structures
- Unify logistical processes in disease control programmes

#### **Resources Mobilisation Plan**

- Prioritise the Health Financing Strategy
  - Overall framework for financing health sector
- Speed up the implementation of the Universal Health Insurance Schemes, NHIF and iCHF
  - Mechanisms for UHC, protection of the poor and vulnerable people
- Revitalise the Basket Funding approach
  - Enhance transparency and accountability
- Map funding of disease control programmes
  - Visibility of use of general resources in programmes
  - Increase efficient use of resources by cutting duplications
- Map and streamline resources at peripheral levels,
  - make them visible in resources provided to the health system

### Completion of other plans started with HSSP V

- Completion of One Plan III with focus on survive, thrive and transform
  - Compete funding and M&E chapters, aligned with HSSPV
- Completion of HRH development plan with focus on innovation in training and management of human resources
  - Priorities interventions according to available resources
- Completion of NCD plan with focus on epidemiological transition and preparation of health sector for new prevention and treatment tasks
  - Elaborate scenarios based in resource mobilization
  - Formulate essential package of health interventions based on scenarios
